Inspired by the remote Himalayan sanctuary, or beyul, of the same name, Pemako is an earthly paradise waiting to be discovered. It is a perfect convergence of person, place and time – where humility restores perspective, spaces inspire wonder and the pace is entirely your own.

## RESORT HIGHLIGHTS

- A collection of 21 luxury tented villas – with private outdoor spaces, heated pools and breathtaking valley views
- Signature arrival – cross a suspension bridge, then pass a waterfall, prayer wheel and choesum (altar) for blessings
- Bhutanese architectural elements – in the Heritage House, tents, chandeliers, dining facilities and more
- Library – a curated collection of local literature and texts
- Enchanting rustic setting – featuring indigenous landscaping, Sorig Garden with seasonal herbs, a hidden beach and Ati picnic deck
- Terma gift shop – for one-of-a-kind memorabilia and keepsakes
- Yantra Hall – 88-sqm meeting room with audio-visual equipment and adaptable seating
- Located on the banks of Mo Chhu river in Punakha – Bhutan's most bountiful valley and winter home of the Je Khenpo (Chief Abbot of Bhutan)

Includes a 72-sqm room, 35-sqm pool and valley-facing deck.

1 Two-Bedroom Tented Villa (431 sqm)  
Two tents (72 & 52 sqm) with en suite bathrooms, connected by a shared outdoor space with a 35-sqm pool.

1 Presidential Tented Villa (720 sqm)  
A grand, two-bedroom tent (144 sqm) and one-bedroom tent (52 sqm) connected by a gangway and 127-sqm deck with a 57-sqm pool. Private dining in the basement.



### LOTUS REALM SPA

Based on the principles of restoring balance and harmony to the mind and body, our spa philosophy is inspired by Sowa Rigpa, the traditional Bhutanese medicine.

- 2 single treatment rooms (34 sqm) – hot-stone bath, bathroom and shower
- 1 double treatment room (26 sqm) – bathroom and shower
- 1 single treatment room (24 sqm) – bathroom and shower
- 2 infrared sauna and steam rooms
- Gym (38 sqm) – fully equipped
- Yoga studio (38 sqm)
- Dedicated foot-massage room
